## ALL SAINTS NEWS

**Foodbank:** contributions for Kids Summer Meals Campaign are much appreciated and cereals, long life milk, chocolate spread, jam, peanut butter, raisins, dried fruit, baked beans, spaghetti hoops, tinned tuna, cereal bars, bottles of squash, and suncream are needed for this. More generally there is a need for lentils, tinned macaroni cheese, Stir Fry Noodles, tinned salmon, cooking oil and flour. Also needed is suncream, children's toothbrushes, razors and sanitary pads. As well as the regular donations, the Foodbank also welcomes egg boxes (6s) which are used to split the large boxes of eggs received from suppliers into individual portions, and freezer/sandwich bags, carrier bags, fruit boxes and decent sized cardboard boxes that they can pack food into or use to store donations.

In June 2024, your donations helped Abingdon Foodbank to distribute 218 food parcels to people facing hardship in Abingdon and the surrounding villages. These parcels fed 602 people, of which 264 were children.

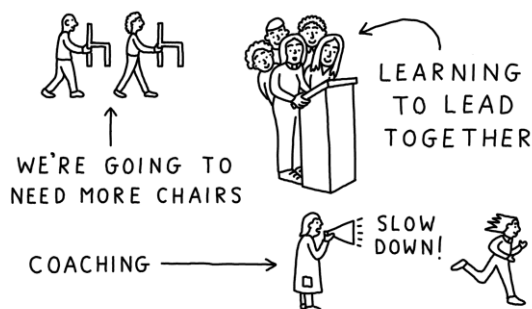

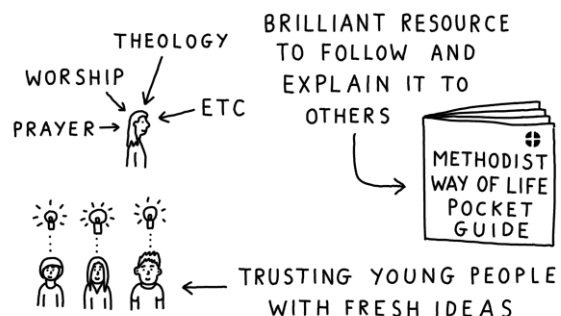
